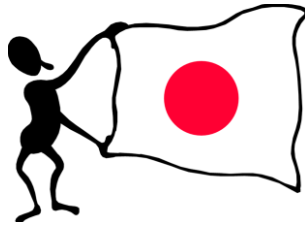


## Homestay Families needed for 2012

Sacred Heart College will again this year act as host to 26 students from the elite Japanese school "Gakushuin" in March of 2012. Gakushuin is the school in Tokyo that the Japanese Emperor's son attended. These students will require homestays with students from Sacred Heart College for four nights from March 26<sup>th</sup> to March 30<sup>th</sup>.

### What is required to be provided by the homestay family:

- Students will need their own room with desk , chair , wardrobe
- Breakfast, cut-lunch and dinner each day
- Opportunities to practice English every day with the family
- Transport to and from school each day  
(bus, car, walk... whichever is normal for the school-age student in the family)



### What the homestay family will gain:

- A homestay payment fee of \$132.00 for the four nights
- An experience of and insight into another culture
- Hopefully, a long term contact for all the family in Japan



The College will hold a pre-visit homestay provider meeting to discuss expectations and give guidelines regarding cultural differences, along with an outline of the programme for the visiting students.
